## **RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. The School begins at 8.45 a.m. Students must be in the school premises ten minutes earlier.  
K.G . to Std II - 8.45 am to 3.00 pm  
Std III to IX - 8.45 am to 4.00 pm  
Std X to XII - 8.45 am to 5.00 pm
2. Students must wear the correct uniform prescribed by the school authorities on all school days.
3. Pupils should not wear jewels made of gold.
4. Students must take care of their own books, lunch boxes etc.,
5. Students who cause wilful damage to the school properties will be expelled from the school. If the miscreant is not identified the whole class will have to bear the responsibility.
6. Students must converse only in English inside the school campus.
7. Good manners are essential.
8. If there is a problem, the parents must discuss it with the Principal or the Correspondent and not with the teachers.
9. Pupils are strictly not allowed to buy any article from vendors outside the school.
10. Parents should inform about their change of address if any, in the school office.
11. Leave applications for three days or less can be signed by the parents.
12. In case of longer leave, due to illness, Medical Certificate must be produced.
13. Achievement record will be duly signed by the parents after every examination, during the Parents Teachers Meet.
14. The School Management has the right to dismiss a student without an prior notice for any of the following reasons.
  - a) irregular attendance
  - b) habitual lack of attention and application

- c) Lack of obedience
- d) Bad manners like hooting
- e) Malpractices of any kind, including causing damage to school properties.
- f) Writing words on the wall and furniture.

15. Parents are strictly warned not to enter the class rooms without previous permission from the school office.

16. Persistent irregularity and lack of punctuality and pupils against whom if there are frequent complaints are liable for suspension or expulsion from the school.

17. Students are not permitted to bring any kind of cell phones into the campus.

18. Students are strictly forbidden from bringing or using cell phones inside the campus. Trespassers will be dismissed and the mobile phone will be confiscated.

19. Students are permitted to use only mopeds (without gear)

20. The students will be dismissed from the school if the parents act and instigate other parents against the Management's rules.

21. Placing the students in any one of the sections in a Particular Class is purely a decision of the Management.

22. Those who apply for T.C. later than 1<sup>st</sup> March will have to pay the fee for one term.

23. Transfer Certificate will be issued only after all fees are paid.
